Registration Rules and Guidelines

Date/Time	Saturday, October 5, 2024 10AM to 3PM
Booth space cost	Lawn Space: \$65.00 per space (11'x11', lawn space (Bring your own tables. Chairs provided.)
Set-up Time	Saturday, October 5 from 6AM-9:30AM (there will be help available to get materials to your assigned area)
Clean-up Time	Saturday, October 5 from 3PM-5PM *Crafters may not begin to break-down before 3PM.

We ask that the following rules be observed. Please read and retain a copy for your records.

- **All items must** be handmade crafts and/or original work. No retail, wholesale, imports or collectable items.
- Crafters must have a completed registration form, signed rules and guidelines form and payment submitted in order to be admitted to the craft fair area.
- Booth spaces are assigned by Oktoberfest committee members.
- All booths must be open and monitored by 10AM, and throughout the time of the event.
- Camilla Hall is not responsible for theft or broken items.
- Crafters are responsible for providing their own tables, decorations, tablecloths, etc. You will be supplied with 2 chairs.
- Crafter items must remain in the boundary of the assigned booth area. Strolling crafters are not permitted throughout the property.
- No hemp, CBD products, weapons or live animals of any kind may be sold.
- Home-made foods may be sold with proof of food license. No commercially produced foods may be sold.
- Food concessions will be available for purchase during the time of the event.
- Do not leave your booth unattended. Crafters need to remain with their booth at all times with the exception of restroom breaks and food breaks. Volunteers will be available to monitor your booth for short breaks, if needed.
- Crafter items must be in good taste. No vulgar or offensive materials may be sold on Camilla Hall premises.
- All registration fees benefit the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary at Camilla Hall.
- Crafters are responsible for making their own change for sales.
- Tents may be erected on external lawn space but must fit in the 11'x11' space.
- The event property is SMOKE FREE and PET FREE (unless a service animal is needed)

All crafters are considered guests of Camilla Hall and must behave appropriately throughout the time of the event. If the above rules are not followed, crafters may be asked to remove products for sale or may be asked to leave the premises.
